

The Cuban musician, Carlos Varela, will be sharing the stage with Bob Dylan in Canada

The Cuban singer and composer, Carlos Varela, will be sharing the stage with the North American singer Bob Dylan, during the Festival of Blues (Cisco Bluesfest) of Ottawa, that will take place from July 7th-17th, as announced by the artist's promoter.

Varela, who is considered by some as the Dylan of Cuba, "has been invited to participate in the Festival of Blues of Ottawa".

Apart from the outstanding US musician, there will be performances by the rapper Kanye West, the French-Spanish singer Manu Chao, and the Canadian Sarah Harmer, as declared by La rueda de producciones Company.

There will also participate the American bands Steve Miller Band and Los Lobos, added the promoter after underscoring that Varela, now 44, "will have the opportunity to sing in Canada, drawing the attention of thousands of people that admire Dylan."

Being the author of some seven disks and anthological topics as 'Guillermo Tell' and 'Jalisco Park', the Cuban musician represents at present the well-known Cuban musical movement called Novísima Trova, heiress of the Nueva Trova -New Trova- represented by Silvio Rodríguez and Pablo Milanes, with whom Varela has also shared the stage inside and outside of Cuba.

La rueda producciones Company pointed out that Varela will also participate during the month of July in other summer festivals taking place in the Canadian cities of Quebec, Toronto, Calgary and Montreal.
